Science and Technology Academics Reinforcing Basic Aviation and Space Exploration

STARBASE VICTORY currently serves all 4th, 5th and 6th grade students in the Portsmouth Public School system. Our students come aboard for a four day hands-on, minds engaged math and science learning experience. "This can't be school, they say...it's too much fun!"

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

- Students wear a T-shirt "uniform" and select their own call-sign to use during their time at STARBASE...in so doing, they become "special".
- Fourth graders learn spatial relationships, mapping and geospatial concepts. They receive a compass to take home.
- Fifth graders learn about climate, weather and the local watershed. Then they make their own video about their experiences.
- Sixth graders learn elementary physics of air and flight. They use a computer flight simulator and build their own rocket... launching it at graduation!
- All classes conduct experiments and activities aligned to Virginia Standards of Learning. Students see how mathematics and science is used in the "real world".
- Self esteem, goal setting and the importance of teamwork are crucial lessons throughout the curriculum.
- An exciting summer program is offered for each of the grade levels.
